IN THE MATTER OF the *National Energy Board Act* (the Act) and the regulations made thereunder;

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Enbridge Pipelines Inc. (Enbridge) for an Order pursuant to section 47 of the Act filed with the National Energy Board (Board) under File OF-Fac-Oil-E101-2012-10 02.

BEFORE the Board on 4 June 2015.

WHEREAS Enbridge has filed an application, dated 6 February 2015, for Leave to Open the Line 9B Reversal and Line 9 Capacity Expansion Project - Partial Leave to Open Application No. 6 pursuant to section 47 of the Act;

AND WHEREAS the Board has issued Order XO-E101-003-2014, the effect of which was to permit the construction and operation of the Line 9B Reversal and Line 9 Capacity Expansion Project;

AND WHEREAS the Board has examined the application and is satisfied that the North Westover 'B', Hilton 'A', Cardinal 'A' and Montreal 'A' facilities as described in Enbridge's Partial Leave to Open Application No. 6, may be safely opened for the transmission of crude oil;

IT IS ORDERED THAT Enbridge is granted leave to open the North Westover 'B', Hilton 'A', Cardinal 'A' and Montreal 'A' facilities for the transmission of crude oil at the specified maximum operating pressures of 1 900 kPa, 4 964 kPa, 6 620 kPa, and 9 930 kPa.
